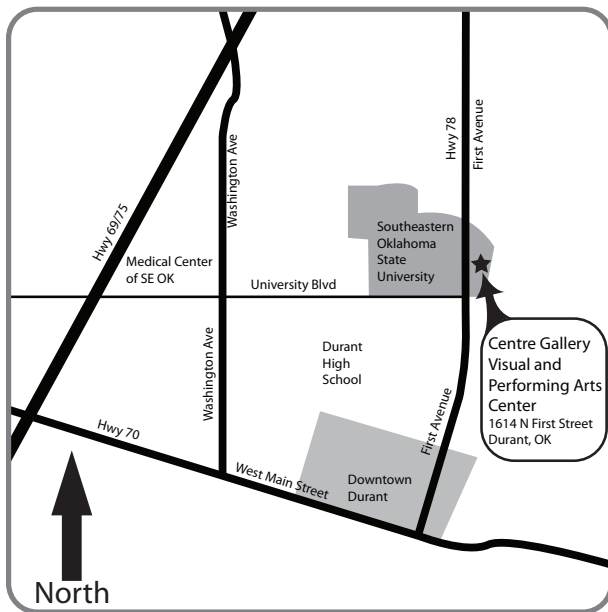

Call for Entries

The Show:

The Great Plains Juried Art Show is open to all regional visual artists.

Sponsors:

This exhibition is supported by funding from the Red River Arts Council, and Southeastern Oklahoma State University.

Entry Procedure:

A **non-refundable entry fee of \$20.00** entitles each artist to submit up to three works for initial jury process; additional work may be submitted for \$5.00 each.

- Make check or money order payable to **SE Foundation**
- Any checks not made out to **SE Foundation** will be returned.

Juror:

The exhibition will be curated by **Jesús Moroles**,



Granite Sculptor. Moroles has more than 2,000 works in place in China, Egypt, France, Italy, Japan, Switzerland, and the United States, in museum, corporate, public and private collections.

To date Moroles' work has been included in over one

hundred and fifty one-person exhibitions and one hundred and seventy-five group exhibitions worldwide. Among his distinctions, Moroles has served on the board as a commissioner at the Smithsonian American Art Museum in Washington, DC.

His most recent distinguished awards include the recipient of the Three Dimensional Texas State Artist Award 2011, the recipient of the 2007 Award for Visual Arts by the Texas Medal of Arts Awards Committee and also recipient of the 2008 National Medal of Arts which is the highest award given to artists by the United States government.

Submission Criteria:

- Works must be the original, unaided work of the artist
- 2D Works must be framed, wired and ready for hanging
- Work must fit through a standard door

Awards:

A minimum of \$1000 in prize money will be awarded at the discretion of the Juror.

Awards are made possible by the Red River Arts Council.

Winners of awards will be required to complete an IRS W-9 form. Centre Gallery will retain a 20% commission on sales of artwork.

Liability:

The artist is responsible for the safe delivery and return of work. SE Centre Gallery can assume no responsibility for the safety of work entered into the Great Plains exhibition.
