NOTE: To be eligible for concurrent enrollment, a high school student must have participated in the American College Test (ACT) or a similar acceptable battery of tests (SAT). **Seniors:** a 20 composite ACT/940 combined SAT score or 3.0 GPA and 50% class rank is required for concurrent admission. A subscore of 19 ACT/460 SAT is required in English/math/science (SAT does not test in science, therefore students presenting SAT scores are not eligible to enroll in science classes) to enroll in classes in those areas. An ACT reading subscore 19/SAT verbal 460 is required to enroll in any other collegiate course (outside the subjects of English/math/science). **Juniors:** a 23 ACT composite/1060 combined SAT score or 3.5 GPA is required. A subscore of 19 ACT/460 SAT is required in English/math/science (SAT does not test in science, therefore students presenting SAT scores are not eligible to enroll in science classes) to enroll in classes in those areas. An ACT reading subscore 19/SAT verbal 460 is required to enroll in any other collegiate course (outside the subjects of English/math/science). No CPT testing will be administered to concurrent students.

*Concurrent students may enroll in a combined number of high school and college courses per semester not to exceed a full-time college workload of 19 semester credit hours. For purposes of calculating work load, one high school credit course shall be equivalent to three semester credit hours of college work.

To be eligible to participate in **pre-enrollment**, concurrent students who are enrolled at the University must provide a signed "**Concurrent Student Permission Form**" and high school class schedule for the requested semester of concurrent enrollment. If the concurrent student fails to maintain a 2.0 GPA for the enrolled semester, the enrollment for the next semester will be cancelled and the student will be charged the \$10.00 non-refundable records fee.

As a concurrent student, I understand that during this provisional enrollment period, I must maintain a 2.0 GPA for each concurrently enrolled semester to continue concurrent enrollment. I also understand I must meet **SOSU's** retention standards, including 1.7 Retention/Graduation GPA to be eligible for regular admission to **Southeastern** after high school graduation.
