Phi Alpha Theta is an international history honor society. Southeastern Oklahoma State University's Rho Chapter has been in existence since the 1920's. To be eligible for membership, you must have completed at least 12 hours of History courses with at least a 3.1 grade point average in those courses, and you must also have at least a 3.0 overall GPA. Students meeting these criteria receive an invitation to membership from the faculty.

The purpose of the society is to encourage and promote historical scholarship. National Phi Alpha Theta publishes a scholarly journal and a newsletter, as well as grants awards. There is an annual conference of state chapters in Oklahoma and biennial national conference.
