1st to 3rd retention within major--students enrolled in the major for the first fall who are still enrolled the next fall or who graduated within the same major by the following summer.

Retention rate is calculated by dividing the sum of the majors in the second fall and the first fall students who graduated in that major within the year by the total majors for the first fall.
