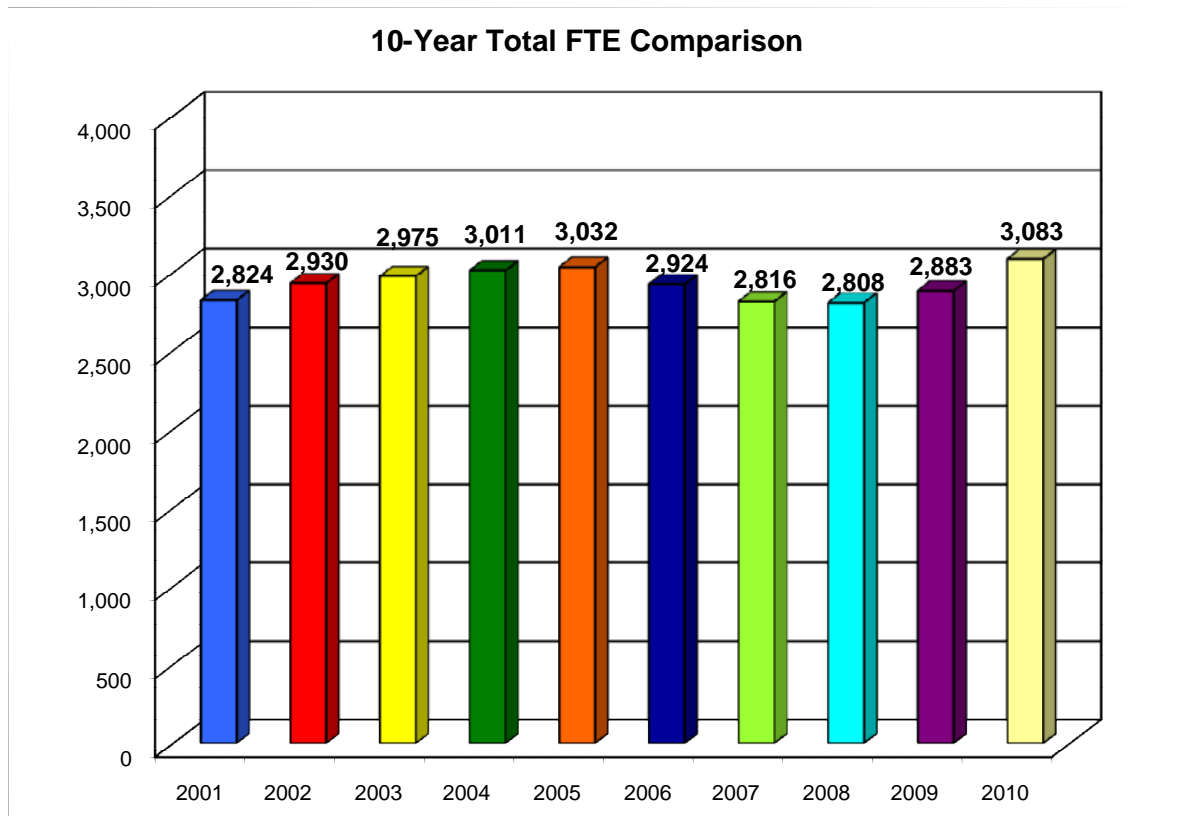

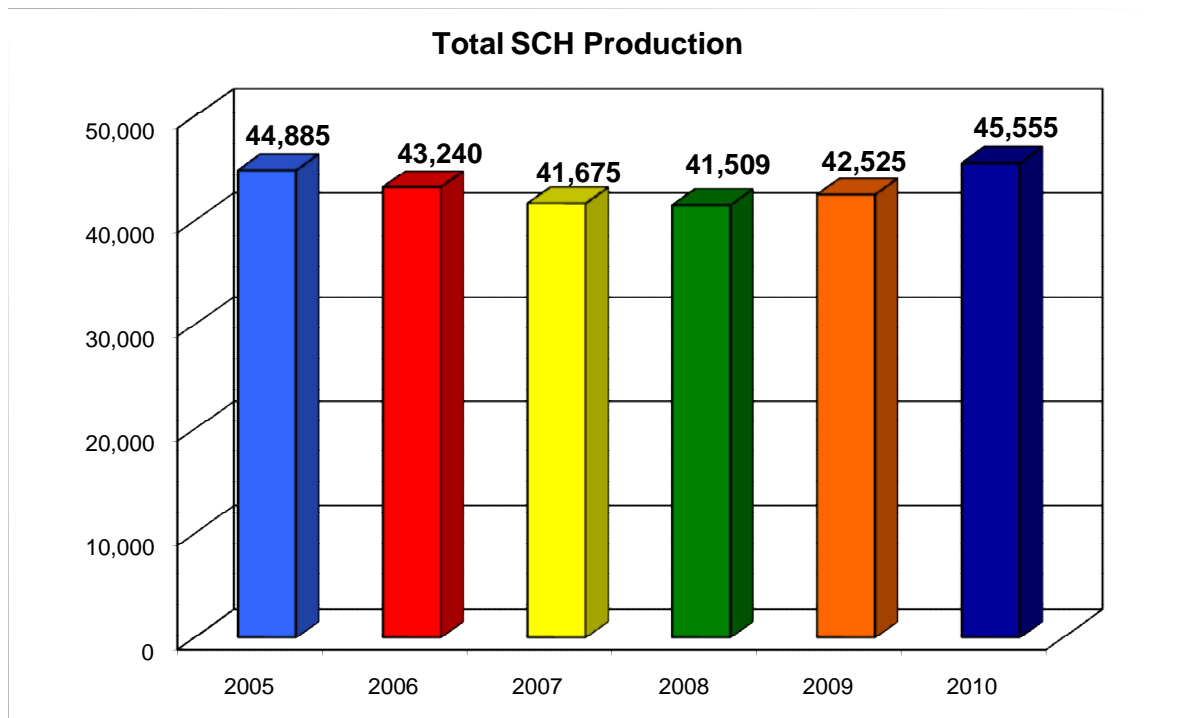

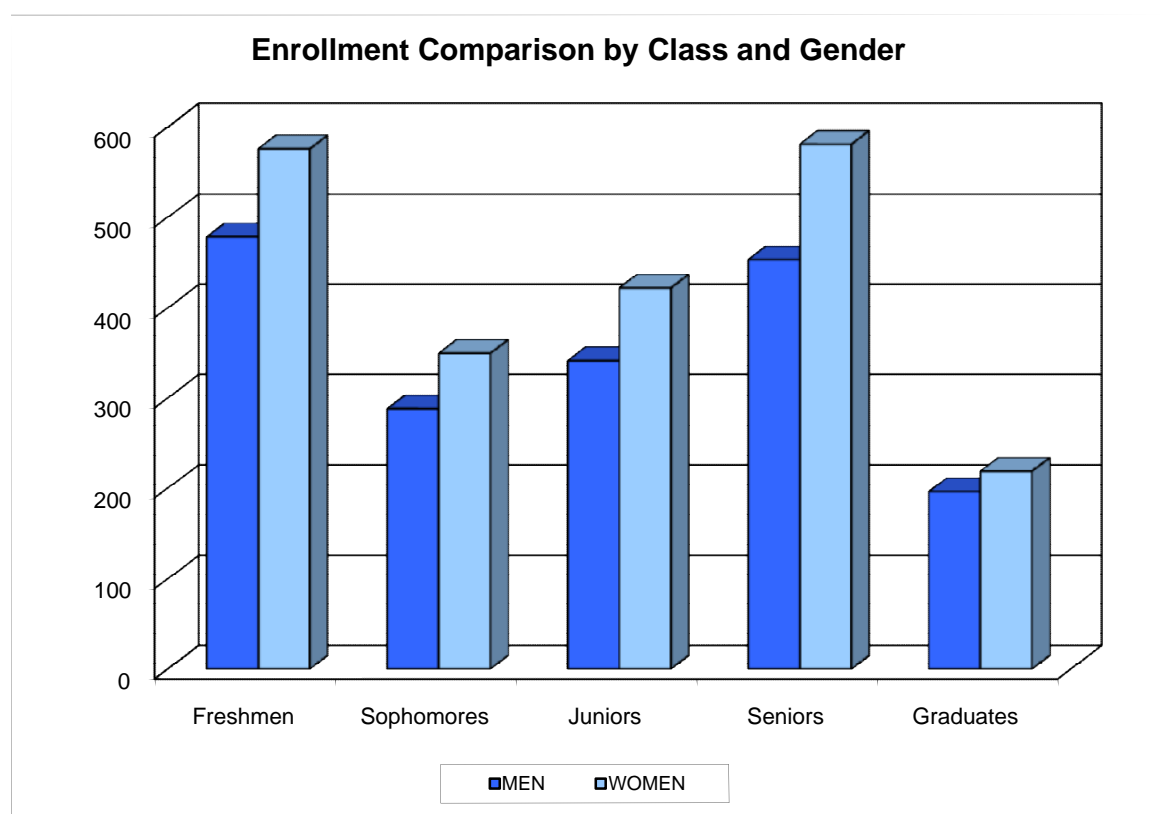

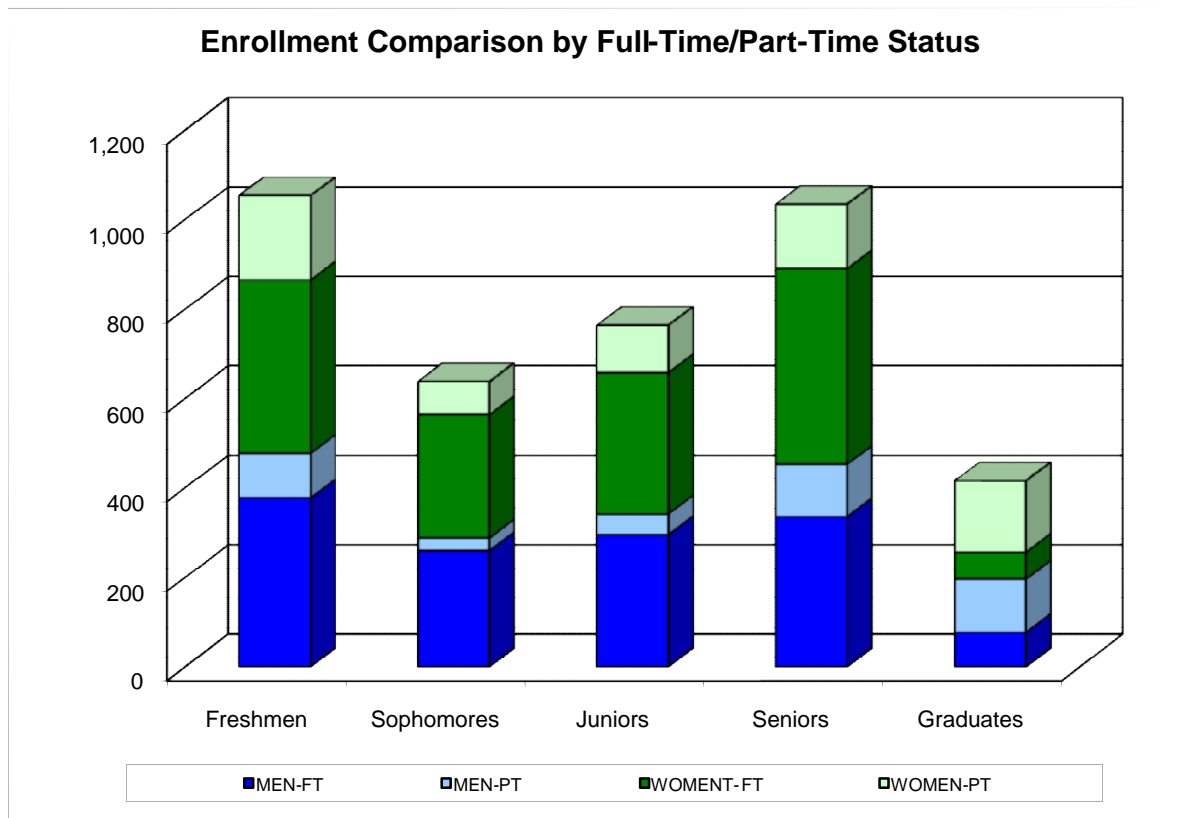

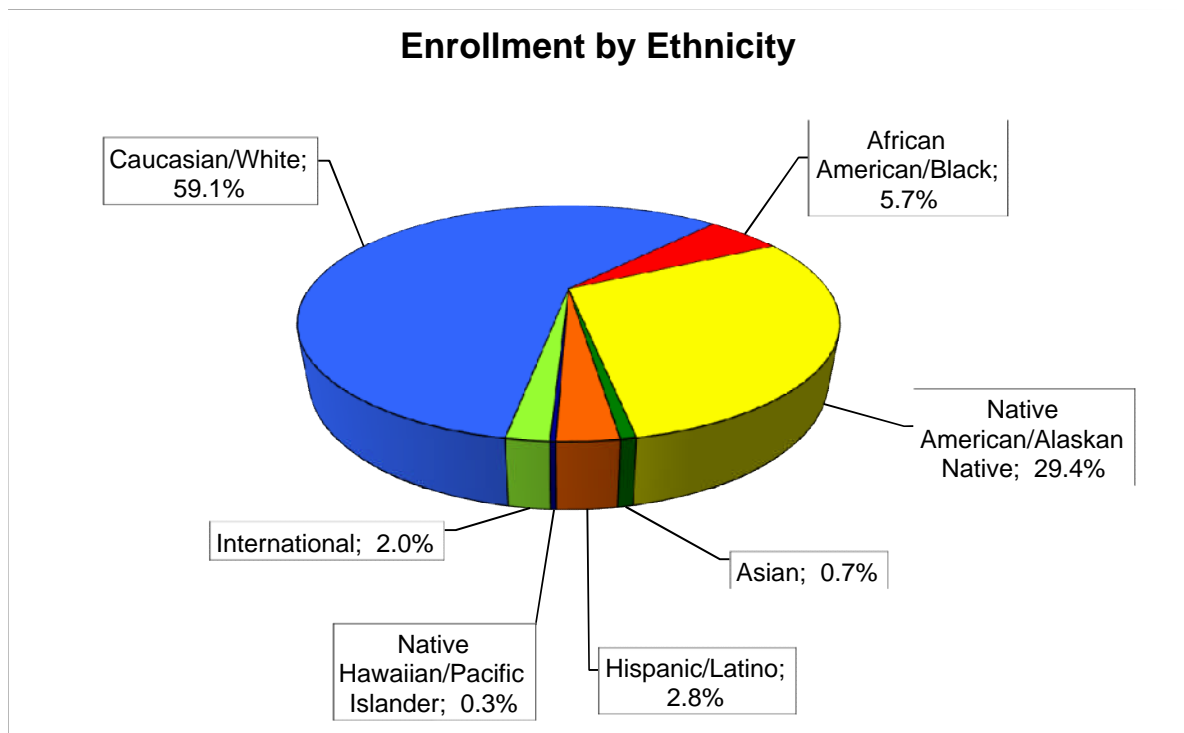

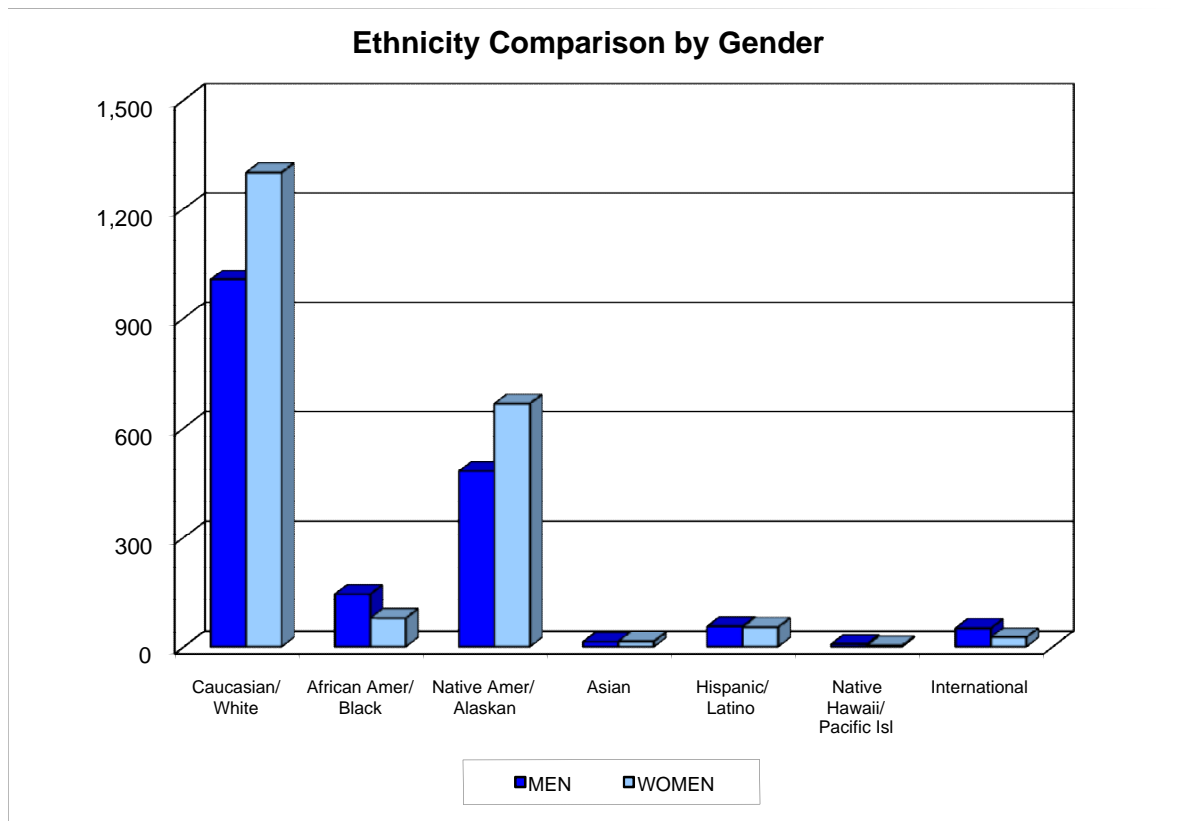

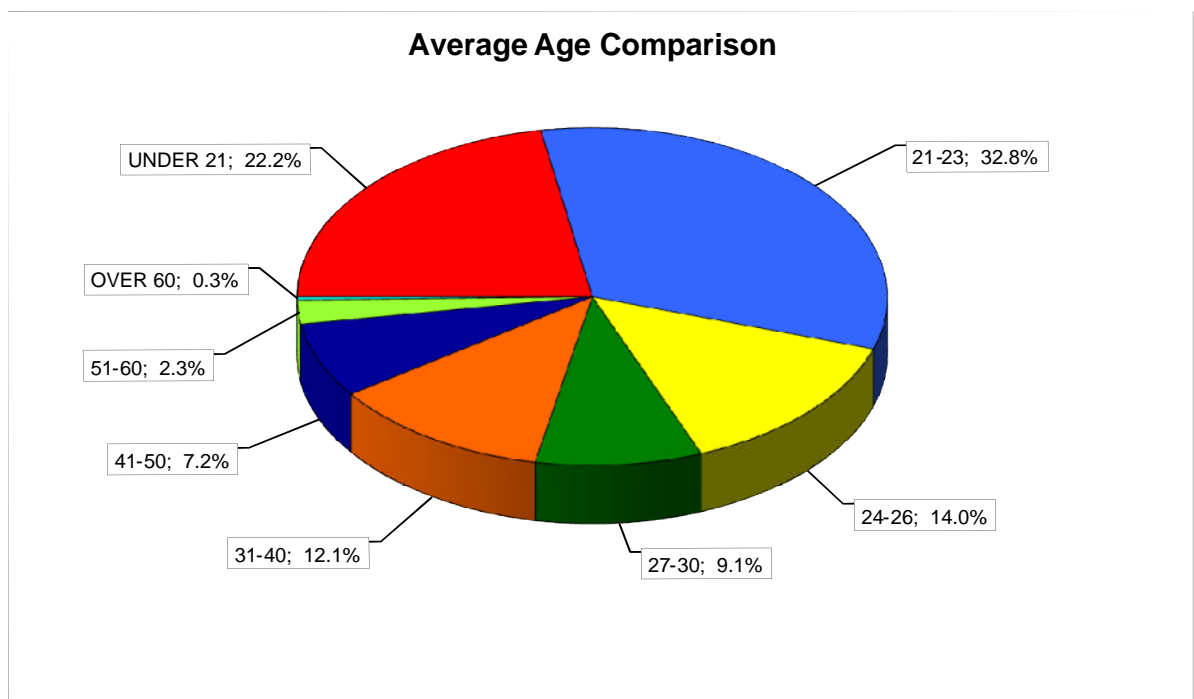

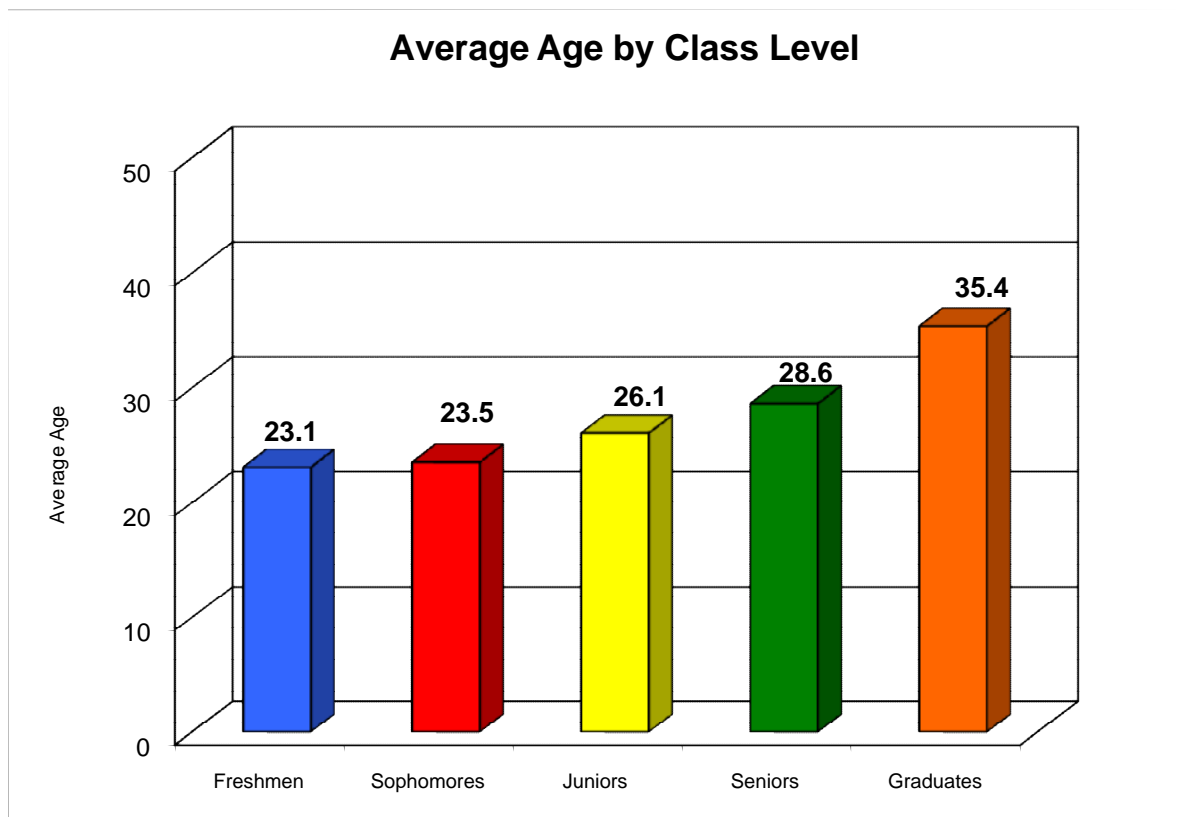

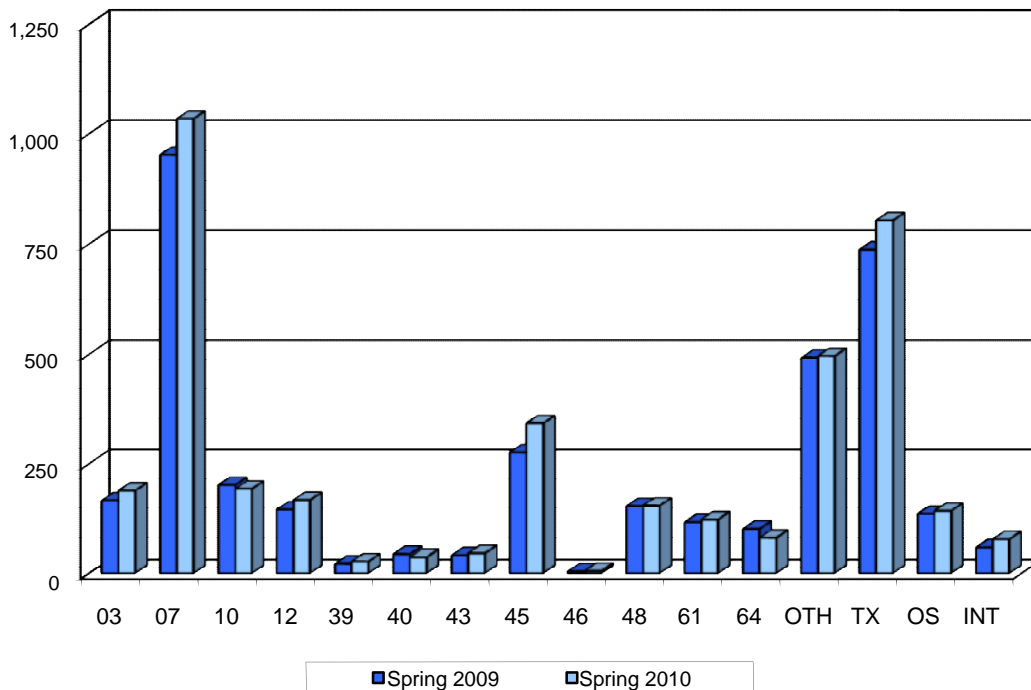

Enrollment by Geographic Origin

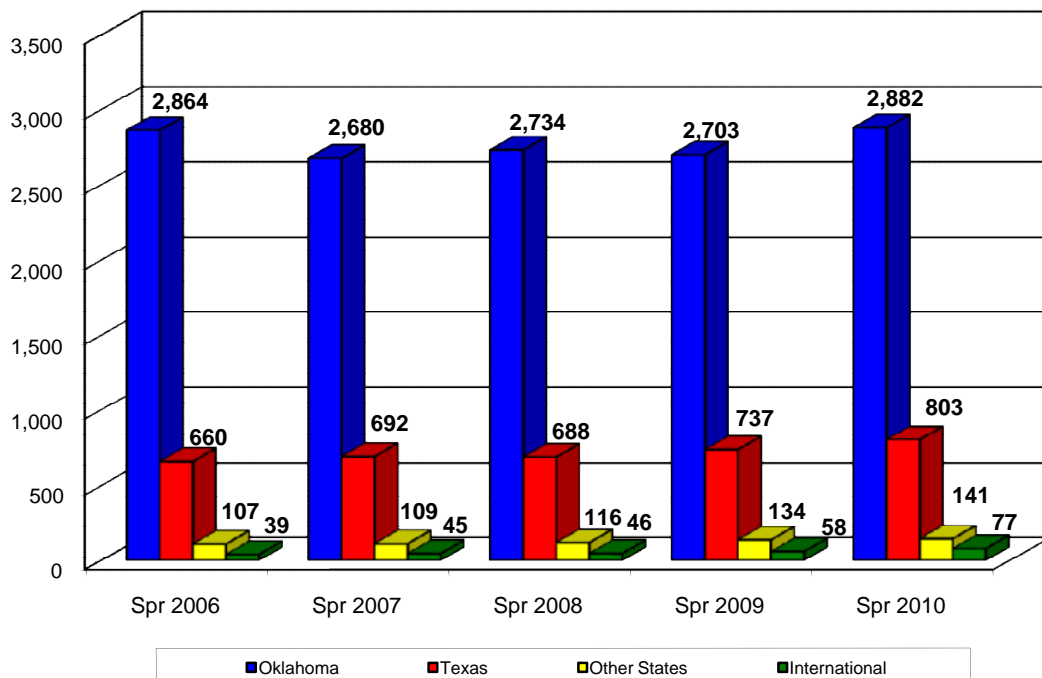

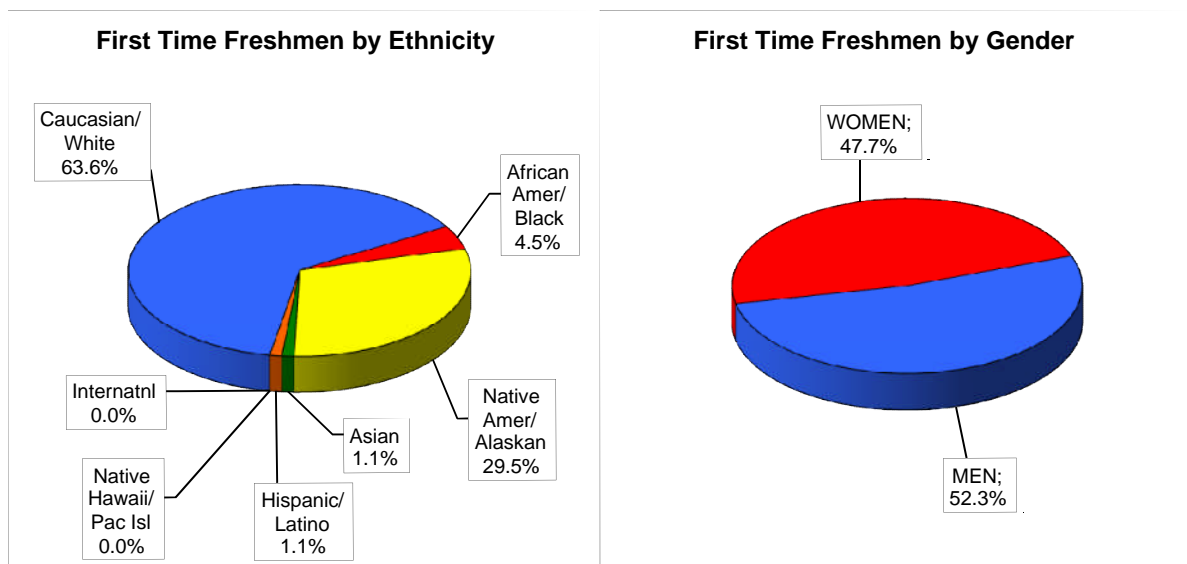

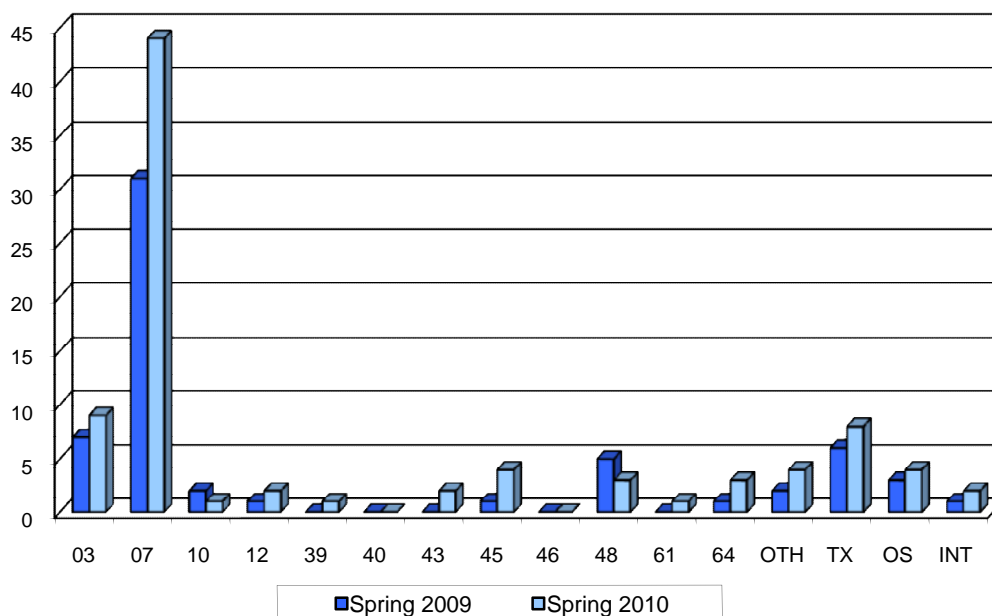

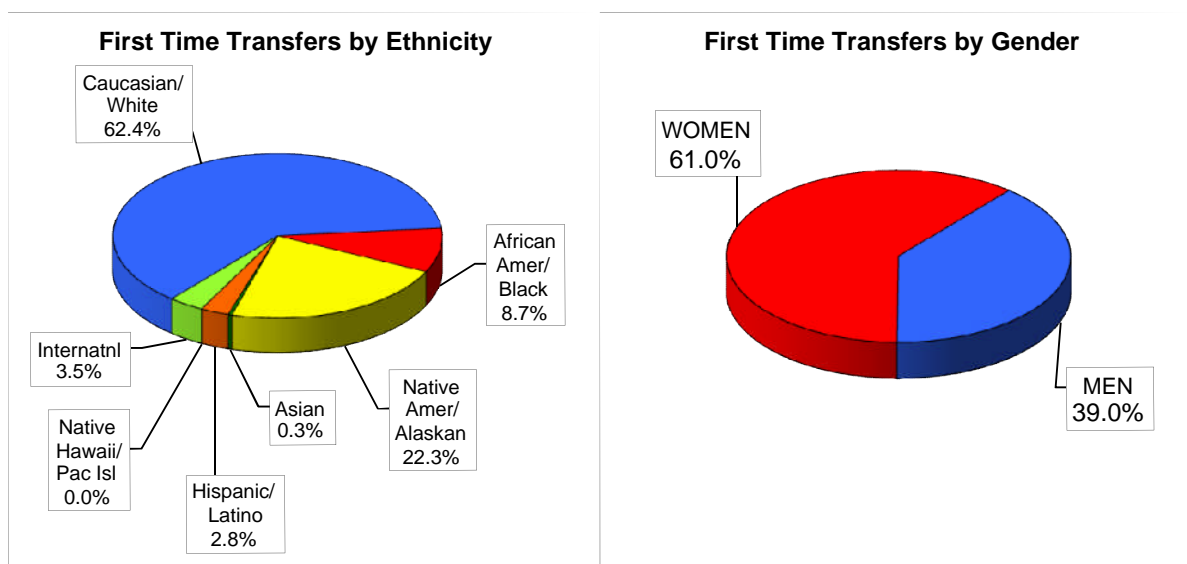
First-Time Freshmen Enrollment by Geographic Origin
