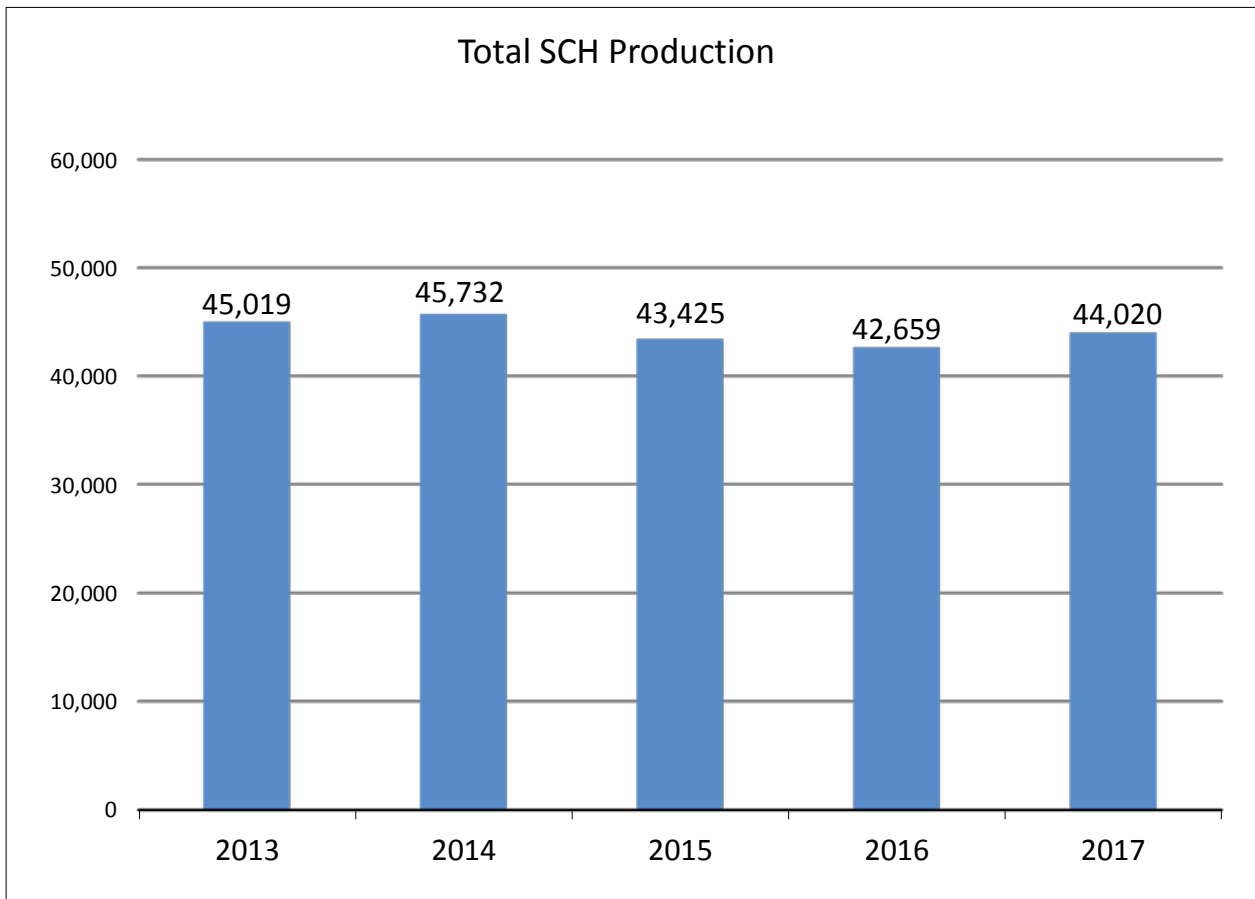

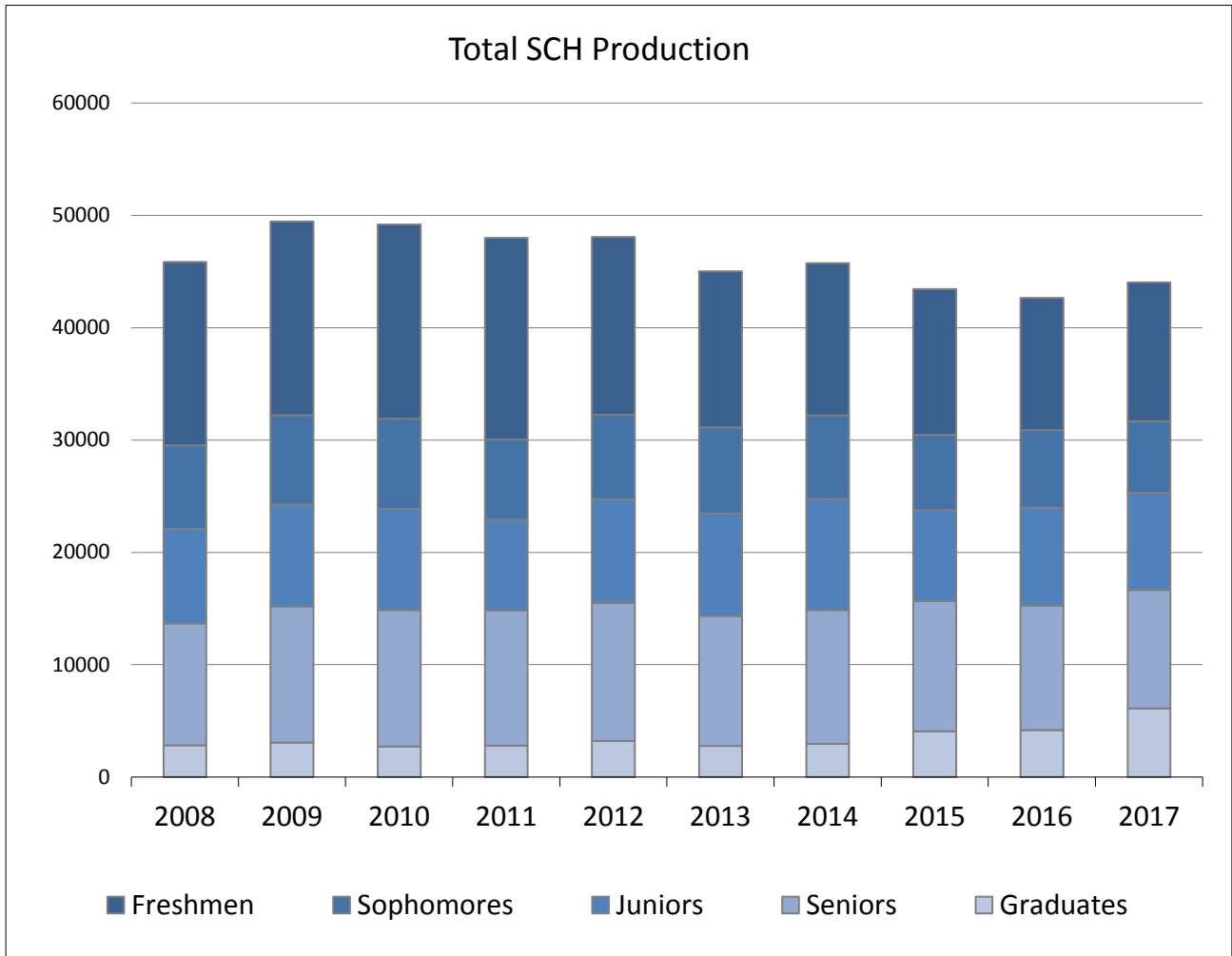

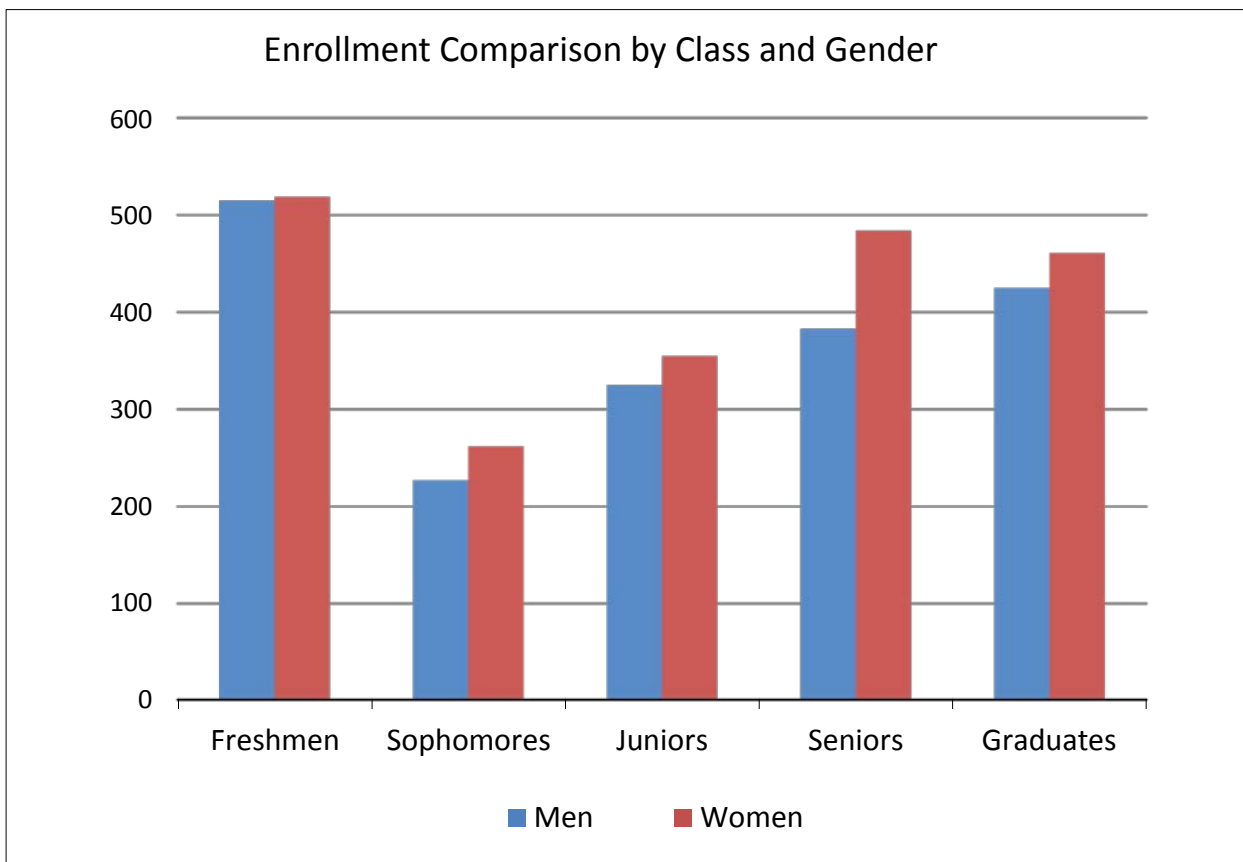




Fall 2017 Enrollment by Class and Gender

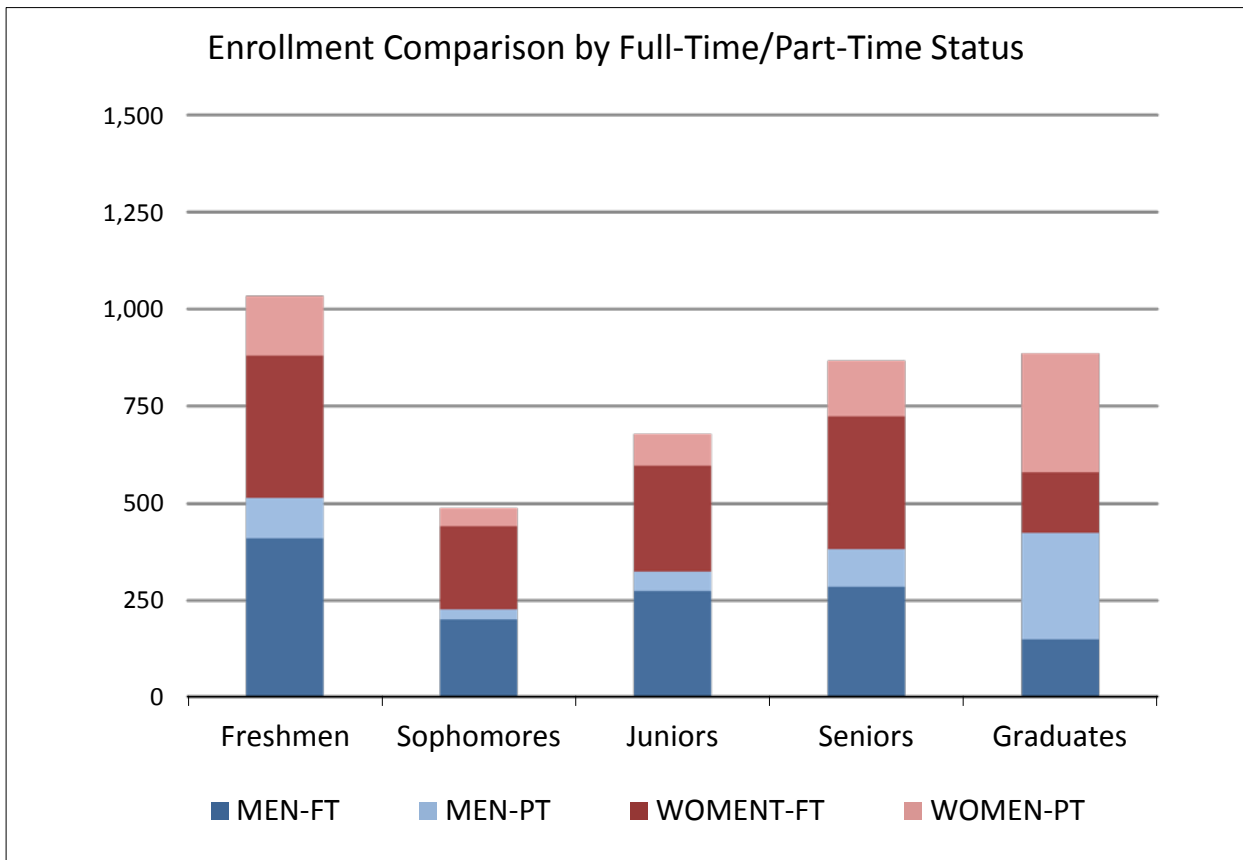

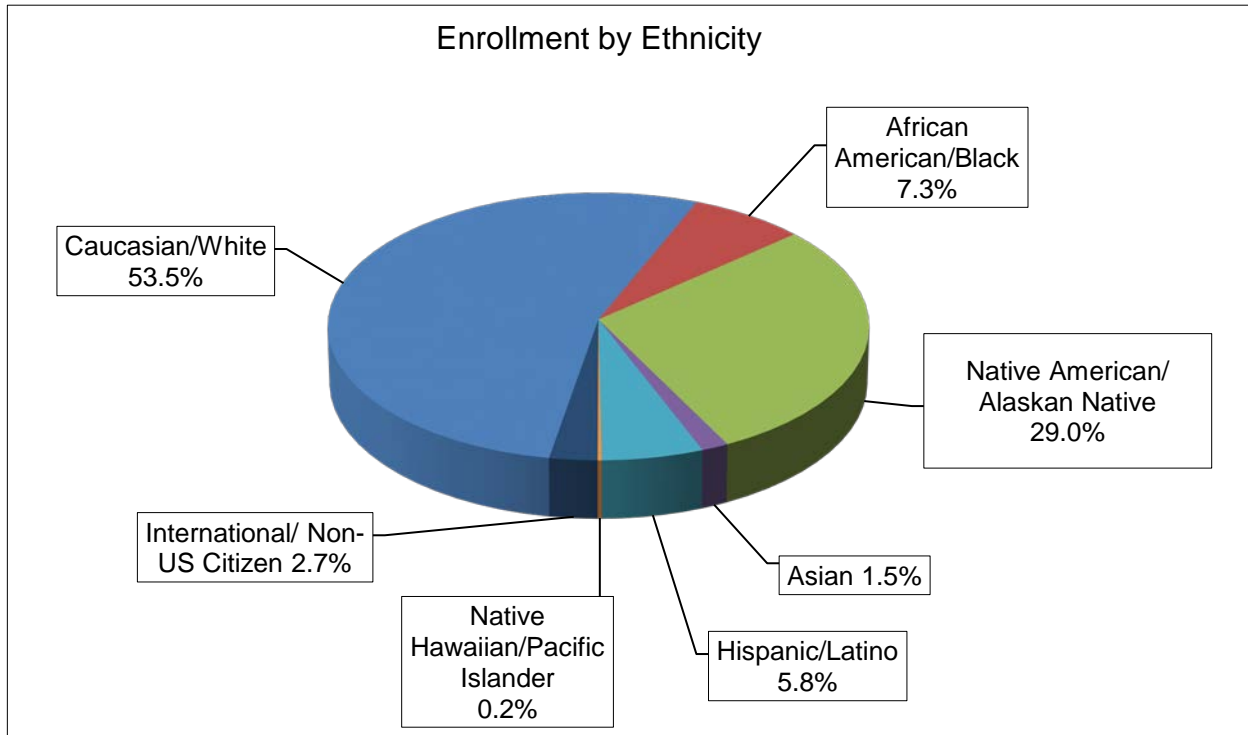




Fall 2017 Enrollment by Ethnicity

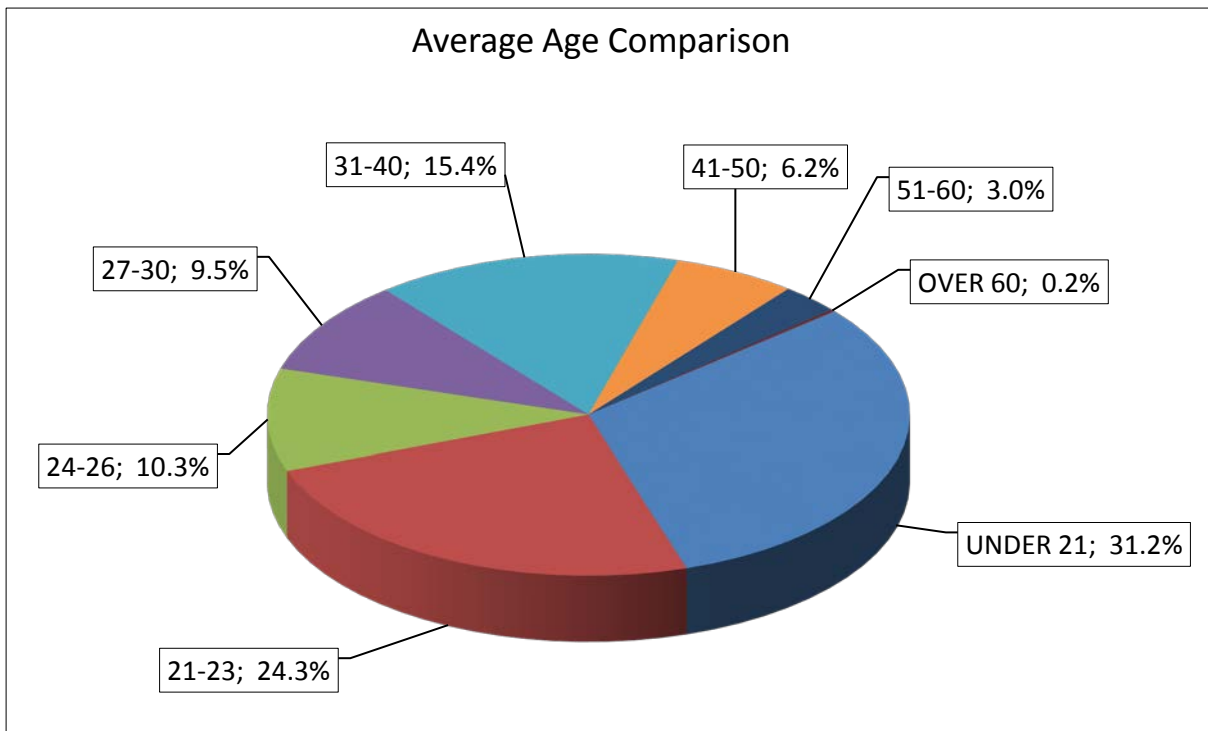

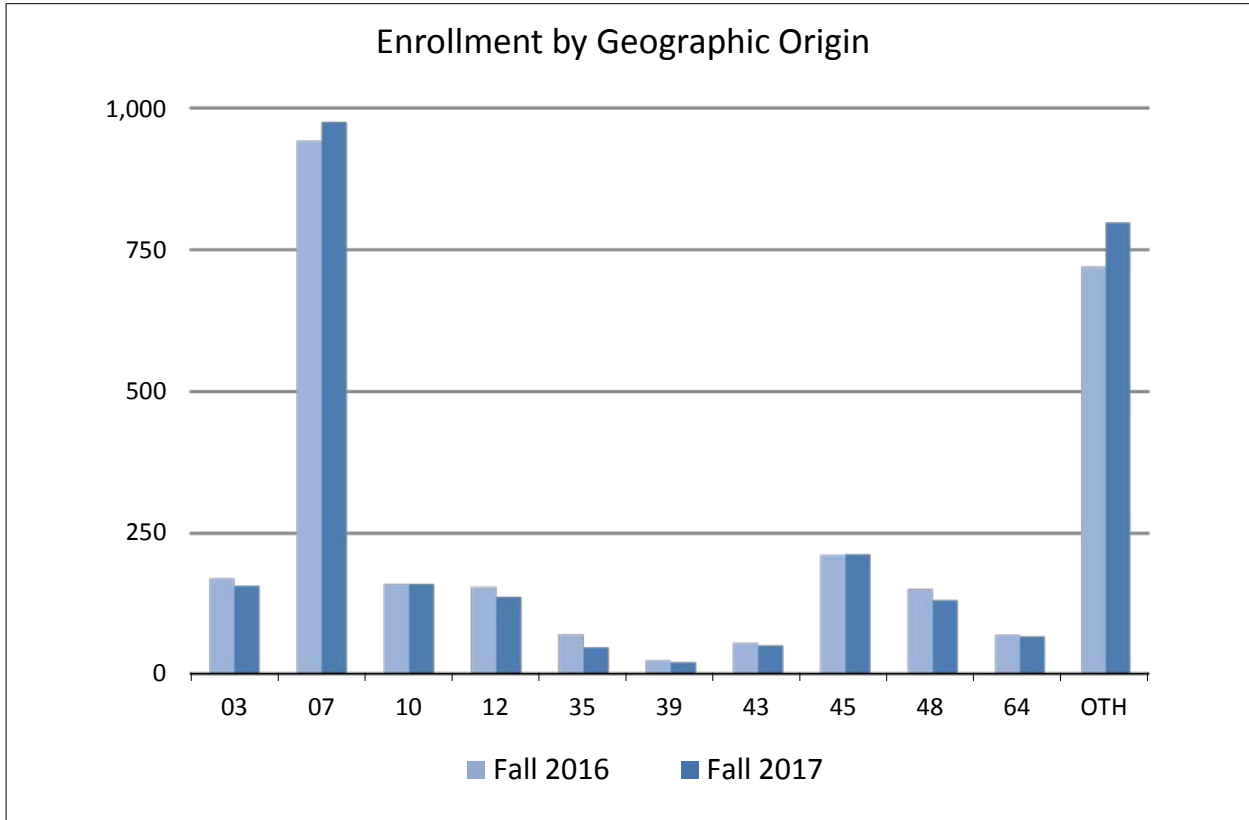

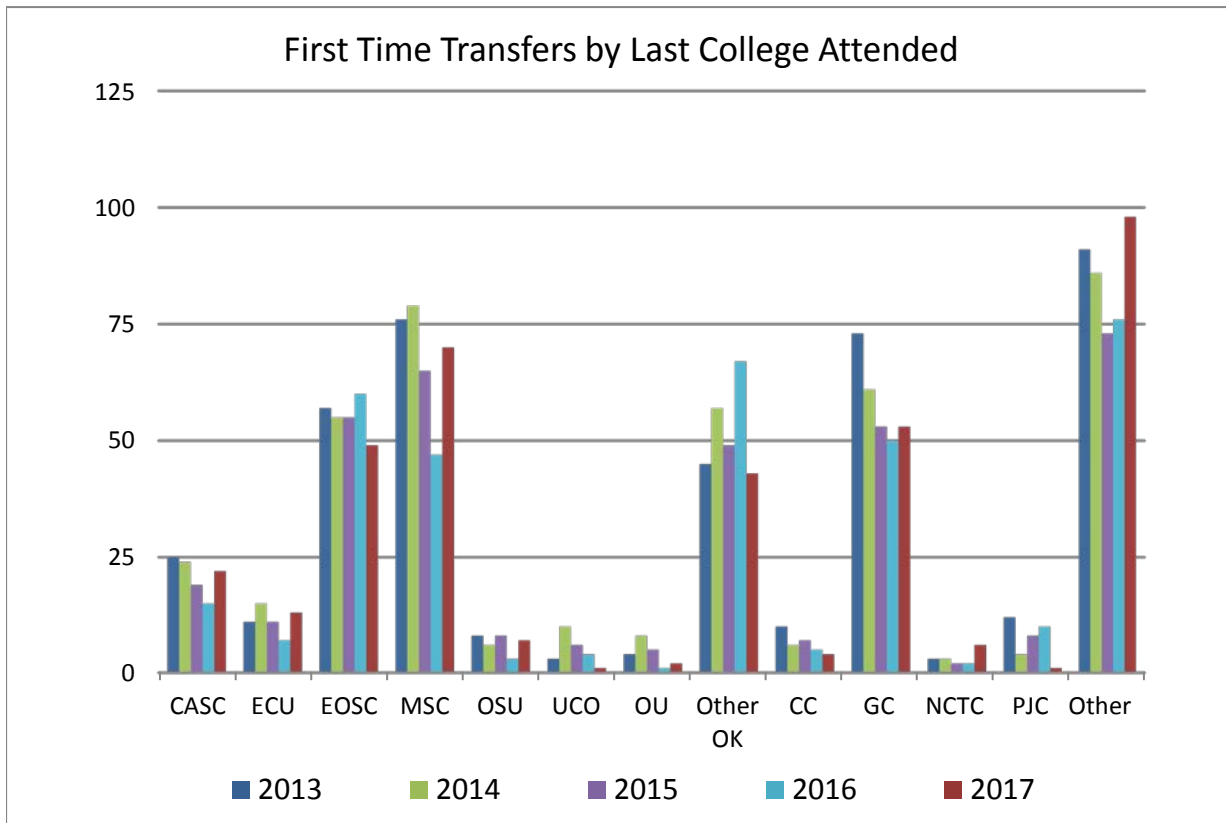
