Southwest Airlines - The Destination 225° University pathway is designed for collegiate aviators who attend a Southwest® partner university. Southeastern ASI is one of four Universities selected by Southwest Destination 225. Southwest assigns pilot employees who graduated from Southeastern as our pilot mentors. They visit campus about once a semester to visit with students, help them with program applications, and to encourage students. Southwest requires an application, and once accepted, the student must maintain a 3.0 GPA to remain in the program.

Delta Air Lines – Delta Propel offers a career path for students at select universities like Southeastern. Successful candidates will be provided a Qualified Job Offer (QJO) detailing a defined path and an accelerated timeline to become a Delta pilot. Delta assigns pilot employees who graduated from Southeastern as student mentors. They visit campus about once a semester to visit with students, help them with program applications, and encourage students. The program requires a Private Pilot certificate and to be a Junior or Senior standing, or a university flight instructor to be considered. An application to the program is submitted via the Propel portal and an interview is conducted to determine if applicants are accepted into the program.
