Situations where CAPS deployment is appropriate:

S.T.I.C.M

SPIN

TERRAIN INHOSPITABLE

INCAPACIATION OF PILOT

CONTROL LOSS

MID-AIR COLLISION

Or

At ANYTIME a safe landing is NOT guaranteed



C.A.P.S PROCEDURE

BLUE: Level Button



RED: Pull CAPS handle



RED: Mixture Cutoff



Accomplish CAPS deployment checklist



Minimum C.A.P.S deployment altitudes

Example: Departing KDUA

BELOW 600FT AGL (1300MSL)

Land straight ahead

Below 13= no help

600FT AGL to 2000FT AGL

(13-2700MSL)

Immediate caps deployment

13-27= chute goes to heaven

ABOVE 2000FT AGL (2700MSL)

Troubleshoot

Above 27= take a second
