




#### Course Hero



Recently, a recurring issue arose with the website known as Course Hero. Course Hero allows students to upload course materials di-

By using programs such as SafeAssign in Blackboard and the Respondus LockDown Browser we can limit a student's ability to cheat, but instances still slip through the thin cracks.
