Interview with Kate Shannon

This week CIDT had the pleasure of interviewing Dr. Kathryn Shannon, an educational technologies professor and an innovative researcher here at Southeastern. Recently, Dr. Shannon received the all-clear on a particularly exciting, both for CIDT and for the university, research topic: accessibility and online course improvement.



Dr. Shannon has had experience in a wide range of classroom settings. She received her bachelor's degree from Southeastern, and continued on to get her master's degree and Ph.D. from the University of Oklahoma. She also worked as an administrator for school districts in Oklahoma and Massachusetts. Her experience in a variety of classroom settings, and her experience working with students and other instructors, have offered insight into the many different learning styles that can be found in the classroom. Every student brings a different learning equation to the table and should be offered course work accordingly. Dr. Shannon's research aims to incorporate this wide range of accessibility and learning support into online courses in the future. She is currently working with a small group of instructors and experimenting with Blackboard Ally, an accessibility program. In the future, Dr. Shannon hopes this research will improve the accessibility of the university as a whole.

We cannot wait to see what great work comes from Dr. Shannon's research, and we wish her the best of luck in her endeavors!

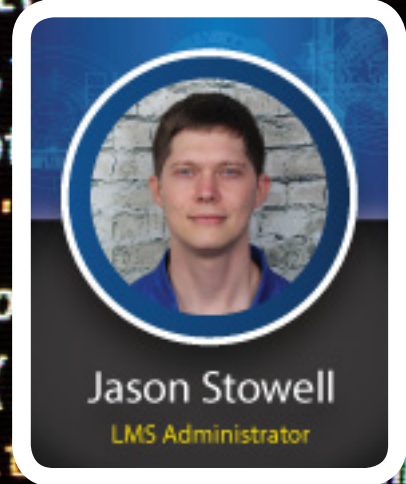
