

GOLD Orientation

Starting in May, all online students were asked to complete

GOLD: General Online Student Orientation. A badge from Orientation must be submitted in an assignment in online classes (and some Face to Face classes). If you have already completed the orientation, you do not have to do so again, but you will need to resubmit your badge when classes start. Submission of the Orientation badge will unlock course work folders. If you have not yet completed GOLD and will be taking an online class in January, be sure to complete it ASAP!


Traditional Track vs. Fast Track

The traditional track is for students that are new to Southeastern, or that would like to refresh their knowledge of Southeastern's online resources. The traditional track follows a series of four Objective folders with various activities that require completion before one can earn their Orientation Badge.

The fast track option is for returning Southeastern students. It is a relatively quick exam that covers the information in the Traditional Track path. Students must score 80% or higher in order to receive their Orientation Badge.


