## RESPONDUS

If you are planning on taking an online course, or you have completed the GOLD orientation,

you may have heard about the Respondus LockDown Browser. Respondus is used by many online instructors to ensure the academic integrity of their exams and quizzes. Respondus exams often require the use of a webcam, and will not work on Chromebook computers. If you have an upcoming exam that requires Respondus, but lack the required materials, feel free to stop by CIDT! We offer quiet computer locations for you to take your exams, and all of the tech support you may need! Our office is open from 8am-8pm.
