Emergency Policy:

Effective April 10, 2020, the following policy will be in force until further notice:

Due to the closure of OGET and OSAT testing sites because of COVID-19, the requirement to pass the OGET for admission to the Teacher Education Program, and the requirement to pass the OSAT for admission to Student Teaching has been suspended for the Fall, 2020 semester. The requirement to pass both the OGET and OSAT to receive the required recommendation for certification from Southeastern Oklahoma State University is still in effect. This policy will be reviewed by the Teacher Education Council as developments relevant to the COVID-19 pandemic occur.
