Question: A rectangular canvas is to contain a small painting with an area of 52 in^2 , and requires 2 inch margins on the left and right, with one inch margins on the top and bottom for framing. The total area of such a canvas is given by the formula

$$A = \frac{4x^2 + 60x + 104}{x}$$

where x is the height of the *painted* area.

1. What is the area A of the canvas if the height of the painting is $x = 10$ inches?
2. If the area of the canvas is $A = 102 \text{ in}^2$, what are the dimensions of the painted area?
