A Resolution Recognizing Scheduling Conflicts due to COVID-19

- WHEREAS;** Students from all backgrounds, have had scheduling and travel conflicts due to location changes and/or format changes.
- WHEREAS;** Many in-person classes are moved to Zoom or other video conference programs because of COVID-19, whether temporarily or permanently.
- WHEREAS;** Students transitioning from on-site to digital classes often times must leave campus for an adequate space to engage in digital learning or find a place on campus where digital learning can be accomplished successfully.
- WHEREAS;** Many students are in on-campus classes before or after classes that have been moved to a digital format.
- WHEREAS;** In order to be on-time for on-campus classes, students commonly "Zoom and Drive", attend classes in their car, or leave digital classes early.
- WHEREAS;** It is a necessary condition for academic success for a student to be in a setting with minimal distractions and ample room for work, note taking, and appropriate technological resources.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE SOUTHEASTERN OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION THAT:

- Section 1:** The SOSU SGA Student Senate acknowledges the overwhelming nature of this pandemic and applauds the University on their efforts toward student safety as well as accommodations.
- Section 2:** The SOSU SGA Student Senate requests that in order for a professor to count attendance for a class towards a grade, that professor must notify their class by 10:00 PM the evening prior to class for classes beginning before 12:00 PM and 8:00 AM the morning of the day of class for classes beginning after 12:00 PM, barring a move or cancelation due to unexpected COVID related or personal emergencies.
