A Resolution Concerning Concealed Weapons on University Campuses.

WHEREAS; The recent history of violence on University campuses involving firearms provides a danger to both students and faculty, and

WHEREAS; The majority of individuals who are licensed to carry concealed weapons have not trained in crisis response, and therefore would not be qualified to use their firearms in a crisis situation, and

WHEREAS; The possession of firearms by anyone not properly trained in crisis situations would cause further hazards not only to themselves but to police, fire personnel and other first responders attempting to deal with a crisis situation on Southeastern's Campus, and

WHEREAS; The carrying of firearms in the classroom may create a sense of fear and tension among both students and faculty; threatening the spirit of free academic expression, inquiry and the intelligent exchange of ideas protected under the First Amendment, and

WHEREAS; It is the opinion of the Southeastern Oklahoma State University Student Government Association that carrying concealed weapons on a university campus would do more to instigate violent acts than it would to deter them, and

WHEREAS; The Council on Student Affairs has already passed legislation in support of Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education Chancellor Glen D. Johnson's efforts to ban concealed and open carry firearms on college campuses.

**THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE SOUTHEASTERN OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY
STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION THAT:**

Section 1: The Southeastern Oklahoma State University Student Government Association supports the current legislation pertaining to campus carry in which the president of the higher education institution decides on a case-by-case basis who can carry a weapon on campus.

Section 2: The Southeastern Oklahoma State University Student Government Association opposes all university, state, or regent's policies above the current policy allowing the carrying of concealed weapons on university and college campuses.
