## General Education Council Meeting Minutes September 26, 2018

- 1. The first meeting for the General Education Council was held on Wednesday, September 26, 2018, at 3:00 pm in R300 with the chair of the council being present.
- 2. The meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm and a quorum was present.

  Roll call: Kathleen Hardgrove, Patrick Reardon, Erica Corbett, Steve McKim, Michael Scheuerman, Glenn Melancon, Rachel Storey, Jamie Knapp, Todd Williams, Michael Reed, Elena Stuart, Ying-Chou Lin, George Jacox, Sandra Thomas and Brett Elliott
- 3. Dr. Elliott ask for volunteers to become the Recorder. Sandra Thomas accepted the role and the Council unanimously approved.
- 4. New Business: a proposal from the Math Department to add STAT 2153 to the Gen Ed program. Guest speaker to present this proposal was Charles Matthews. This proposal came as a result of the Oklahoma State Regents' Math Pathways Task Force which has recommended that college students be directed into one of four distinct mathematics classes based on their intended major:
  - a. Courses:
    - i. Quantitative Reasoning (SE's MATH 1303: Math in the Liberal Arts
    - ii. Modeling (SE's MATH 1543: Algebra for the Sciences
    - iii. Statistics (SE's STAT 2153 Statistical Methods)
    - iv. College Algebra (SE's MATH 1513: College Algebra this is only recommended for students needing to take Trigonometry or Calculus I)
  - b. Glenn Melancon made a motion to accept the proposal and it was seconded by Todd Williams. A discussion followed outlying objections/concerns. One concern is that Stats may be only Math course taken. If students are required to take a Math course (with a Math heading) in addition to the Stats, this could cause an undue burden on the present Math department (5 professors down from 10); however, if a student does not have at least 19 on their MATH ACT, they will still be required to complete MATH 1303, 1543, or 1513 as a prerequisite for STAT 2153
  - c. A call to question was made by Jamie Knapp. It passed with a vote of 15 Yes/0 No and No Abstention
- 5. Old Business: ACT CAAP phased out. Now administering the ETS Proficiency Profile Exam for the assessment of General Educ. This test will be administered on October 19, 2018.
- 6. Potential dates for future meetings if needed: October 24 and November 7.
