I. Welcome

Dr. Mayers called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm. Drs. Daigle, Morrison, Stout, Heald, Boothe, Ms. Darla Ellett, Ms. Carolyn Fridley, Mr. Jon Hazell and Ms. Jennifer Arnold. Dr. McDonald and Caleb Smith attended via Zoom.

II. Approve Minutes from November 21, 2019 Meeting Ms. Fridley moved to approve the November 21, 2019 minutes and Dr. Stout seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

III. New Business

a. Suspension of the B.S. in Special Education program

Dr. Mayers informed the TEC the EIL department and discussed and approved the suspension of the undergraduate Special Education program for three years. Dr. Boothe explained the program needed much updating as well as marketing plan to try and rebuild enrollment.

b. Social Studies Education Program

Dr. Mayers reported he had met with Drs. Heald and Melancon to begin the process of writing to the new NCSS Standards (2018). Assessment 1 is completed and Assessment 2 is nearly completed.

c. New TES Position

The new data collection special position for the TES office has been advertised. Jennifer Arnold and Drs Stout and Mayers will serve as the screening committee.

d. OEQA/CAEP Annual Reports

Dr. Mayers informed the TEC these reports are due April 30. He asked for all teacher education faculty to report to him any changes made in teacher ed courses, in either content or delivery, to him by March 31.

e. Title II Report

This report's deadline has been pushed back to May 29.

f. Program Reports and C & W Module 3's

Dr. Mayers reported that, other than vocal and instrumental music and art, all programs are required to submit program reports by March 15, 2021. Data for these reports should be collected in a Module III in C 7 W. Any department who needs help to develop/update their Module III need to contact Jennifer Arnold. Dr. Mayers will meet with each program area faculty to help them get started.

g. SE Education Day/Prospective Teacher Academy – April 24

Darla Ellett reported on the invited guests for SE Education Day on April 24: Dr. Mary Ann Shepherd in the morning (teacher workshop) and Dr. Tim Faltyn in the afternoon (administrator workshop). Jon Hazell reported on the line up for SE's first ever Prospective Teachers Academy.

h. Certification Test Results (Fall 19)

Dr. Mayers distributed aggregated results from Fall 2019 certification tests. The good news: 11 of 13 passed the School Counseling exam and 4 of 5 passed the Early Childhood Education exam. The OPTE, ELED Part 2, and OGET are areas for concern.

IV. Old Business

a. PPAT updates to EDUC Courses

Dr. Mayers report on course updates to begin student development for the PPAT. Drs. Fridley, Shannon, Boothe, and Mayers have all additional coursework in the EDUC/SPED core.

b. Certification Test Results/Prep Needs

Dr. Mayers would like for program coordinators to begin working on developing certification exam preparation support for their students. This item will be discussed in future meetings.
