- II. Approve Minutes from February 25, 2021 Meeting
Dr. Mayers asked for a motion to approve the minutes from February. Dr. Daigle moved to approve and the motion was seconded by Dr. Walker. Then Dr. Mayers asked if there was any correction to the minutes. The minutes were approved unanimously. Mrs. Fridley asked if the minutes could include the name of who submitted them. Dr. Mayers, said, yes we can do that.

- III. New Business
 - a. ELED Course Modifications
Dr. Morrison introduced a request from the EIL Department to change the prerequisites to the following courses: ELED 3513, 3523, 3533, 3543, 4444, 4513, 4533. The catalog currently lists a GPA of 2.5 or higher and a passing score on the OGET. The ELED faculty has proposed eliminating those prerequisites because GPAs and OGET scores are checked prior to admission to Teacher Education. The ELED faculty also proposed changing the name of ELED 4803 from “Methods of Instruction for Elementary Teachers” to “Elementary Education Professional Capstone” to better match the content of the course. Dr. Stout moved to approve and Dr. Boothe seconded. There were no questions or discussion. The motion was approved unanimously.

 - b. Music emphasis for M.Ed. in C & I Degree
Dr. Mayers reported the music department has requested the addition of a Music emphasis to the M.Ed. in C & I Program. This has been discussed in both the EIL Department and the Music Department. Dr. Walker then asked if anyone had questions. There were no questions. Dr. Daigle made a motion to approve and Dr. Boothe seconded. The motion was approved unanimously.

 - c. Magnolia Scholarships
Jon Hazell was said that this time they are only able to give one Scholarship this year. Please let him know if you have someone who this would help out. There were 2 names suggested and several TEC members agreed they are worthy. Mr. Hazell reported there was a possible of a second scholarship. If that occurs, both students would receive scholarships. The students discussed, in order of need, were Stacey Hernandez and Victoria Gonzales.

 - d. CAEP/OEQA Annual Reports
Dr. Mayers said thank you everyone who has help get the 10 Program review done. They are not done. We do have 3 more reports to finish in April. The OEQA Report is

90% finished. If you have done any work in the public schools, please send your hours for that to Dr. Mayers. There is a form, "PDP 2021" on the TES Blackboard site that you can fill out for that. Dr. Walker asked if zoom meeting could count. The answer is yes. CAEP Annual Report is almost finished. If you have made changes in your courses areas, please let me know. Let me know what the changes were and what data were used as the bases of the change(s).

Emergency Policy for Certification Exams

Dr. Mayers said that this was in place due to the COVID issues. Question is are we still wanting to keep this in place? Do we want to keep in effect for the fall semester?

Jennifer said that the test scores are coming in slowly and that more testing sites are opening. Do we want to make an exception if a student can document a lack of access to an appropriate testing site? Is this a decision for TEARC? Dr. Morrison said that we need to reinstate the testing requirement back to prevent having students graduate who have not passed any certification tests. Dr. Boothe, asked can we do this on a case to case basis. The item was tabled.

NOTE: The following day, the TEC considered, via email, a motion a motion by Dr. Walker to discontinue the emergency policy, reinstating the testing requirements for admission to Teacher Education and Student Teaching. Darla Ellet seconded. The motion was approved by a unanimous email vote on March 30.
