#### Programs Typically Leading to Certification

School Counseling and Educational Leadership lead to Oklahoma certification. Many states allow students to obtain Oklahoma certification and then transfer the Oklahoma license to their state. Oklahoma certification requires a passing score on the Oklahoma Subject Area Test (OSAT) in School Counseling, Principalship, and Superintendent. The OSAT is offered

nationwide at any Pearson Vue Testing Center.
