7. Develop an assessment process that includes a written plan with documented results. This process MUST incorporate relevant evidence used to regularly assess the program. The results of the assessment MUST be used to effect continuous improvement of the program and must include each of the areas listed in Criterion 3.10.1. The assessment plan, process, and implementation must include the requirements of Criterion 3.10.2, 1-4.

Provide an updated listing of the material provided in the institution's response to Recommendation 7, and the resulting continuous improvement for the program.

Enclosed with this letter is a public release policy, which has been excerpted from the AABI Policies & Procedures Manual. Please advise appropriate members of the faculty and staff of the necessity to adhere to this policy. A Certificate of Accreditation from AABI is also enclosed, along with a list of accredited programs.

On behalf of the AABI Board of Trustees, congratulations and thank you for the confidence you have placed in AABI and the commitment that you have evidenced toward quality aviation education through membership and successful reaffirmation of one program. Since AABI accreditation for this program will expire on July 31, 2027, we suggest that an application be
